



Dear Forest Park Families,

At Forest Park Elementary School, we take pride in the appearance of our students! Research has shown that school uniforms have a positive impact on student performance and conduct. Their attitude toward academic achievement is directly enhanced. Students are required to wear the basic selected school uniform as outlined below*.

BOYS

- Pleated or flat-front pants or shorts – khaki or navy
- Short or long-sleeved polo-style shirts with a 3-button collar: solid white or solid forest green, with or without a Forest Park logo
- Additional products with the Forest Park logo: forest green or navy crew-neck sweatshirts, navy ¼ zip sweatshirts, zip-up fleeces or pullovers

GIRLS

- Pleated or flat-front pants or shorts – navy or khaki
- Jumper, skirts, skorts – navy, khaki, or Forest Park plaid
- Short or long-sleeved shirts can be 3-button polo-style, or button-up with a Peter Pan collar; white or forest green, with or without a logo
- Long-sleeved button cardigan or cable sweaters: (no hoods) navy, white, or evergreen
- Additional products with the Forest Park logo: forest green or navy crew-neck sweatshirt, navy ¼ zip sweatshirts, zip-up fleeces or pullovers
- Tights: solid navy or solid white
- Plain full length leggings: solid navy

ALL CHILDREN

- Socks must be solid white or solid black
- Coats: Only Forest Park logo apparel is allowed to be worn inside the classroom
- Belts: Belts are required for 1st through 5th grade students, if their pants or shorts have belt loops. Pre-K and Kindergarten students are encouraged to wear them, but it is not required.
- Footwear: for health and safety, socks and sturdy shoes must be worn that permit active movement; open-toe or backless shoes are not permitted (i.e. flip-flops, clogs, platform/high-heeled shoes, Crocs or Birkenstocks)
- All shirts must be tucked in.

NOT PERMITTED

- Cargo-style, camouflage, denim and corduroy pants or shorts
- Hoods are not permitted. All non-Forest Park coats/fleeces/jackets are to be hung up once students enter the classroom.

SPIRIT DAYS

Fridays or last school day of week

- Forest Park spirit t-shirts
- Shorts and pants: khaki, navy or denim

FREE DRESS DAYS

Free dress days are to be announced, reasonable clothing is allowed at the discretion of the principal.
